Special Directions to make the work accessible to a wide range of students...

- 1. Any run of 16th-notes or faster may be more easily communicated to younger students as a glissando.
- 2. Trombone 3 is optional, more intended for a Bass-Trombone player, but playable as Trombone 3 by more experienced players.
- 3. Octaves throughout the piece and for *any instrument* may be adjusted *at any time* based on the needs of the individual players.
- 4. Individual players unable to play the triplet-16ths at measure 9 may substitute a single staccato 8th-note.

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
